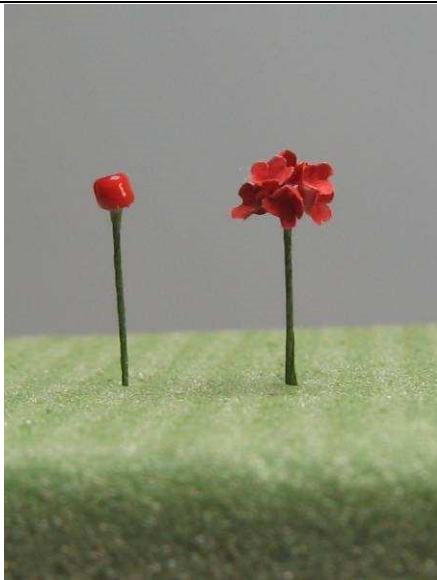
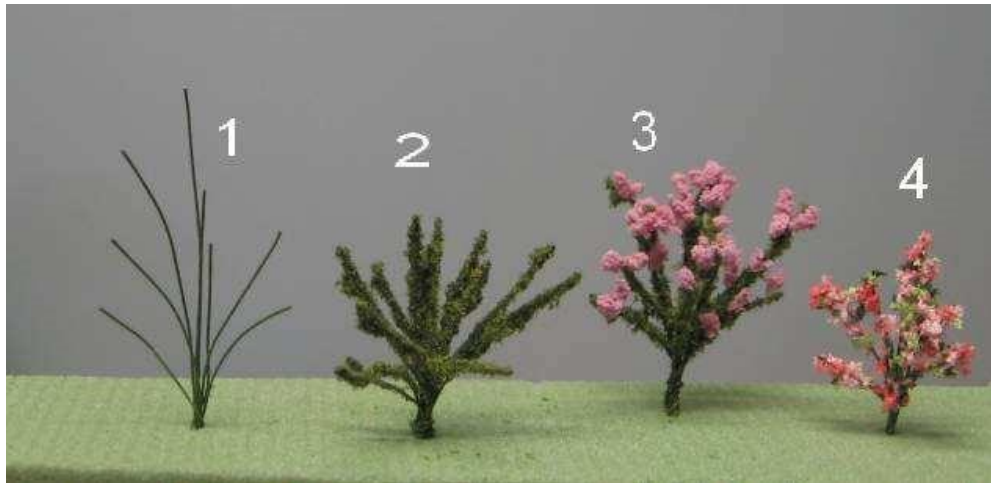


BLOOMS FOR YOUR SPRING AND SUMMER GARDEN



Geraniums

Glue a seed bead onto a piece of floral wire. Punch and cup small petals. Glue petals onto the seed bead to form a geranium. When dry, attach punched leaves to the wire stem. Insert into flower pots or into the ground.

Solid or Flowering Shrubs

Twist strands of floral wire into your desired shape as in figure 1. Coat the wire with glue, dip it into fine green foliage, press into place and shake off excess as in figure 2.

In figure 3, glue was dabbed onto the ends of branches and dipped into floral foam for sort of a crepe myrtle effect.

In figure 4, glue was randomly painted onto the branches and dipped into floral foam.
